Summary:

On June 2, 2023, the Burke County Sheriff's Office responded to Amber Lane in reference to a larceny. The investigation led to 4628 Amber Lane where multiple stolen items from several larceny reports were recovered. One of the items recovered was a camper/travel trailer valued at \$70,000.

On June 5, 2023, during a follow up investigation at 4628 Amber Lane, investigators discovered a second stolen camper/travel trailer on the property that was valued at \$25,000. The camper, along with additional stolen items including furniture and lawn equipment, were also recovered at this location. April Michelle Richardson was arrested without incident and charged with two counts of felony possession of stolen property, one count of felony breaking and entering, one count of felony larceny after breaking and entering, and one count of felony injury to property to obtain nonferrous metals. Richardson was issued a \$40,000 secured bond and given a court date of June 8, 2023.

After further investigation, charges were also issued for Robert Paul Hubbard who was arrested on June 7, 2023. Hubbard was charged with one count of felony breaking and entering, one count of felony larceny after breaking and entering, and one count of felony injury to property to obtain nonferrous metals. Hubbard was issued a \$10,000 secured bond and given a court date of June 8, 2023.

The total value of stolen items that were recovered from this location is approximately \$96,500.00. The investigation is on-going.

June 13, 2023
