Clinical Services:

Primary Care

Any person (3 and older) may come and be screened for well/sick visits by our advanced care provider.

Cash/check, Medicaid and other insurances soon to be determined. Minimum charge of \$50.00. By walk-in or appointment.

Child Health

Provides Well Child check-ups for children birth to 21 and school exams for upcoming kindergartners. For more information, call 828-764-9177 or 828-764-9224

Family Planning

Provides birth control for women who desire to delay or space pregnancies. Education, exam, and birth control methods are provided. For vasectomy counseling and referral contact Lisa Moore at 828-764-9218.

Maternity Clinic

Provides complete service for pregnant women to ensure healthy babies and moms. Referrals are made for childbirth and prenatal classes.

Communicable Disease (CD)

Provides services to investigate, treat, and educate on suspected and confirmed CD cases including Tuberculosis (TB) and Hepatitis C.

Must meet certain criteria to be tested

STD Clinic

Provides services to anyone who may have, or suspects they have a sexually transmitted infection (STD). This clinic offers diagnosis and treatment. HIV testing is also available.

Immunizations

Provides immunizations or "shots" for children and adults. The clinic is available on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Walk-ins should call ahead. Other Health Services:

WIC

(Women, Infants and Children Program) WIC is a special nutrition program for pregnant, recently post-partum women and children from birth to age 5. WIC provides nutrition education and specific, basic nutritious foods for those who qualify.

Pregnancy Care Managers (PCM)

Pregnancy Care Management services are available to pregnant women enrolled in NC Medicaid statewide. If you have certain conditions or risk factors, you may qualify for PCM. Examples include having had a preterm baby, a chronic illness such as diabetes, or concerns, like wanting help to quit smoking.

Care Coordination 4 Children (CC4C)

A program offered at no charge for Burke County families who have at risk children birth to 5 years of age. CC4C care managers are nurses that assist families who have children with long term medical conditions, and/or who are dealing with challenging levels of stress; and/or are referred by the child's doctor. Your child's care manager will work closely with your child's doctor to meet his or her needs."

Health Education
